Chennai itself is home to the second longest urban beach in the world and is also a popular destination for medical tourism.





- **Location**

Chennai is located on the South Eastern coast of India, alongside the shorelines of Coromandel Coast. The city occupies a total area of 426 square kilometres, divided into four broad regions, each with their own highlights.

- **Exploring Chennai**

Marina Beach, St.George Fort, Harbour, Kapaleswarar Temple, San Thome Cathedral, Parthasarathy Temple, Government Museum and Art Gallery, Theosophical Society, Kalakshetra, institution for Indian classical dance and music, National Deer Park, Snake Park are just a few of the vast array of places to see.

- **Kanchipuram**

The temple town of Kanchipuram, 64 km from Chennai, was the ancient capital of the Pallavas. Famous as a city of 1000 temples, it still has 124 shrines. The first temple, dedicated to Shiva, was built in the 7th and 8th century and has rare paintings on the walls.

- **Mahabalipuram**

Mahabalipuram is famous for its seven pagodas- a group of ancient rock hewn temples on the seashore. They are an excellent example of the Dravidian style of architecture.

- **Climate**

Chennai has a tropical wet and dry climate with a monsoon season lasting from June to September. However, because of its proximity to the coast, the city does not suffer from extreme temperatures. Winters occur between November and February, with January being the coolest month of the year. This is considered the most pleasant time of the year to visit the city.
