Italy is a country located in Western Europe bordering France, Switzerland, Austria and Slovenia - with a long Adriatic and Mediterranean Sea coastline. It includes Sicily and Sardinia and has 2 enclaves for San Marino and the Vatican Holy See. Italy is famously

Italy dangles from the centre of Western Europe like a stocking filled with marvels, some as inspiring as the Leaning Tower of Pisa, Venice and St Mark's Basilica, others as strange as the pagan tombs lying deep beneath Rome. There are the snowy peaks of the Alps in the North, the gently smoking caldera of Mt Etna in Sicily and the picture-perfect villages of the Italian Riviera.

- **Climate**

Italy has a wide ranging climate although generally the weather follows the pattern of traditional European climates. The best time of the year to visit Italy tends to be when the weather isn't too hot or too cold. April to June and September to October are ideal times to visit weather-wise - with calm, mild temperatures and fewer crowds. Italy is not a particularly humid country which make the hot July and August weather more bearable. Northern Italian winters can be long and cold - perfect for skiing - while in the south the weather is much milder.
