- ### • Major Festivals

Every year, Hyderabad comes alive with a wide spectrum of festivals that people from different communities celebrate together. The Deccan Festival is one of the most popular festivals organized by the Department of Tourism, Andhra Pradesh. Celebrated around

February or March, this five day festival echoes authentic Hyderabadi culture and also prominent projects Nawabi cuisine. **Sankranti is the harvest festival and last for 3 days. In the festival** People fly kites and decorate their houses with Rangoli to mark the beginning of the harvest festival. **Lumbini Festival** is celebrated to honor the Buddhist legacy of Andhra Pradesh. - **Climate**

The temperature in Hyderabad in October is between 22°C degree and 30°C whereas it drops to a minimum of 20°C and stays within 25°C in November. During the months of December and January the temperature in Hyderabad cuddles in between 15°C and 20°C and it is this time when you can enchant the city tour and its ambiance. The temperature in Hyderabad in February and March slightly rises to a maximum of 27°C and In April the temperature rises to a high of 35°C. In the months from June to September the city receives medium to heavy rains and may be associated with heavy winds.
