Shopping

Kerala's famous polished metal mirrors or Aranmula kannadi, rosewood artefacts, coir floor coverings and tablemats, old dowry boxes from Travancore, gold jewelry exclusive to Southern India, cotton saris, traditional khadi (handspun and handwoven) attire and antiques from Jew town, aromatic spices and exotic cashews, ornaments made of coconut shells or bamboo cane, miniature models of snake-boats.

Special Attractions

Kathakali dance performances and Kalari Payattu demonstrations of physical exercises and mock duels.

Major Festivals

Onam – Kerala's new year and harvest season celebrated between August and September and Temple Festival.
