## **Oman Air stops Flights to Zanzibar Airport 19 July 2005**

Mr. Ziad Karim Al Haremi announced that effective Tuesday 19 July 2005 and till further notice, Oman Air, the National Carrier of the Sultanate of Oman, shall stop all scheduled flights to Zanzibar International Airport. Oman Air will continue to operate non-stop flights to Dar-es-salam.

He added that due to this unexpected emergency situation, Oman Air regrets to its valued passengers any inconvenience that may be caused and the same time assures Oman Air commitment to safeguard the passenger's liabilities.

Mr. Al Haremi confirmed that Oman Air shall take any measures that help to eliminate the impact of this decision. Such measures include the possibility of refunding the price of the issued ticket or providing transportation from Zanzibar to Dar-es-salam for which Oman air operates 5 weekly scheduled flights.
