Oman Air is pleased to announce the inauguration of its first scheduled flight to Bahrain, the “Pearl of the Arabian Gulf” on 12/4/2004. This will increase the number of Oman Air destinations to 20, since the launch of the first Oman Air flight to Salalah on 15/3/1993.

The Omani Khanjar, the emblem of the company, will fly to Bahrain on 5 days of the week, Saturdays, Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays in accordance with the following schedule:
