The Royal Opera House Muscat (ROHM) is Oman's premier venue for musical arts and culture. The operahouse is located in Shati Al-Qurm district of Muscat on Sultan Qaboos Street. Built on the royal orders of Sultan Qaboos of Oman, the Royal Opera House reflects unique contemporary Omani architecture, and has a capacity to accommodate maximum of 1,100 people. The opera house complex consists of a concerttheatre, auditorium, formal landscaped gardens, and cultural market with retail, luxury restaurants and an art center for musical, theatrical and operatic productions. Drive past the Royal Opera House. Visit the Bait Al Zubair Museum, exhibiting the wealth of Oman's history and thus imparting knowledge about the country's rich culture and traditions to the visitor. Later you drivealong the picturesque Corniche to the once walled district Muscat. You will have photo stops at the official residence of his Majesty, the Al Alam Palace, which is flanked by the 16th century Portuguese forts Miraniand Jalali. You will be strolling through Muttrah Souq, where you will be bargaining for handicrafts and silver items.
